


# The Truth about Staggering

- The staggering of U.S. and U.K. pub dates is hurting sales
- Staggering is typically 6 months
- Because book buying is often impulsebased,
- People won't wait 6 months to buy a book they want now

# **Publishers Have Lost Control**


- They can no longer control who talks about a book, nor when they talk
- Though they still control where and when you can buy it through e-bookstores
- Authors need to talk to their agents and publishers about changing this obsolete practice





The novelist Iain Pears has just published a fascinating column in the Guardian entitled "Why You Need an App to Understand My Novel."
